My name is Gerald Emperor, and I am the landowner of the property at 30347 3400 Road Dwight IL 60420.

In accordance with the letter titled "Public Notice of Hearing" I am submitting this letter as a formal notice of my concerns associated with the construction of the "Project" near my property.

Please be advised that I have provided several significant financial investments into this property since I acquired it in March of 2020, highlighted most recently by a project to enlarge my pond as a water source for the property and to regrade the berm area surrounding the pond.

With this said, my concerns are as follows:

- 1. Once the construction is started, I am concerned about the dust and other airborne particulate matter settling in my pond, which could then have a negative impact on my water quality, the aquatic vegetation, and the fish in my pond
- 2. Once the construction is started, I am concerned about the dust and other airborne particulate matter settling on my pond berms, which could then have an impact on my ability to grow and maintain vegetation on them, which is needed to avoid erosion primarily to maintain the proper shallow entry angle of the shoreline, as a necessary safety feature if someone accidently falls into my pond
- 3. Once construction is started, I am concerned about the security of my property (i.e. the potential for trespassers) as I currently do not reside on my property, nor do I have it fenced in

I realize that these concerns are contingent upon how close the construction will be to my property and the actual time frame when the construction will be started.

I did however want to make my concerns known via this public forum; so that that there is a record of them.
